**Driver Disqualification:**

*You may be disqualified from operating a CMV if convicted of any of the following major offenses in a CMV or non-CMV.*

Check all that apply:

- Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol.
- Convicted of driving under the influence of a controlled substance.
- Refusing to take an alcohol test as requested by a state or a jurisdiction.
- Convicted of using a vehicle to commit a felony.
- Convicted of using a vehicle in the commission of a felony involving the manufacturing, distributing, or dispensing of a controlled substance.
- Convicted of having an alcohol content of 0.04 or greater while driving a CMV.
- Convicted of causing a fatality through the negligent operation of a CMV.
- Convicted of driving a CMV, when as a result of prior violations committed operating a CMV, the driver's CDL is revoked, suspended, or cancelled, or the driver is disqualified from operating a CMV.

*Any combination of two or more of the following offenses in a CMV or non-CMV will disqualify the driver from operating a CMV.*

- Excessive Speeding, 5 mph or more above the posted speed limit.
- Reckless driving.
- Making improper or erratic traffic lane changes.
- Following too closely.
- Violating a state or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic control (other than a parking violation) arising in connection with a fatal accident.

- Driving a CMV without obtaining a CDL.
- Driving a CMV without a CDL in your possession.
- Driving a CMV without the proper class of CDL and/or endorsements for the specific vehicle group being operated or for the passengers or type of cargo being transported.

***You may not drive a CMV unless you are physically qualified.***

Check all that apply.

- Have lost a foot, leg, hand, or arm and have not been granted a waiver.
- Have an impairment of a hand, finger, arm, foot, or leg, which interferes with your ability to perform normal tasks, associated with driving a CMV and have not been granted a waiver.
- Have diabetes requiring insulin for control.
- Have heart disease, which causes you chest pain, fainting, or shortness of breath.
- Have chest or breathing problems like chronic asthma, emphysema, or chronic bronchitis.
- Have high blood pressure likely to interfere with driving.
- Have loss of movement or feeling in part of your body.
- Have any sickness, which is likely to cause loss of consciousness or any loss of ability to control a CMV.
- Have any mental problems likely to interfere with your ability to drive a CMV safely.
- Have poor vision that affects your ability to see objects that are far away, objects to the side, or traffic signal colors. You may not drive if you see with only one eye.
- Have poor hearing.
- Use certain drugs and dangerous substances that would affect your ability to safely operate a CMV.
- Have a current clinical diagnosis of alcoholism.
