

COMMERCIAL TRAINING CONTRACT

COURSE RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

1. STUDENT MUST MAINTAIN A PROFESSIONAL ATTITUDE WITH RESPECT FOR THE INSTRUCTOR, THE EQUIPMENT, AND ALL OTHER PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY ABC.
2. STUDENTS MUST OBTAIN A 2.0 GPA OR BETTER IN EACH SEGMENT TO SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE COURSE.
3. ATTENDANCE FOR ALL COURSE SEGMENTS IS MANDATORY. EXCESSIVE ABSENCES MAY RESULT IN FAILURE OF COURSE AND FORFEITURE OF ALL FEES PAID. EMERGENCY SITUATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED ON A PER CASE BASIS. FOR ALL EXCUSED ABSENCES, MAKE UP TIME MUST BE ARRANGED WITH THE COURSE INSTRUCTOR.
4. TUITION INCLUDES ONE (1) SET OF REQUIRED COURSE TEXT BOOKS AND/OR LEARNING MATERIALS. STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REPLACING LOST OR DAMAGED MATERIALS AT AN ADDITIONAL FEE.
5. TUITION DOES NOT INCLUDE TRANSPORTATION, MEALS, OR LODGING.
6. SMOKING IS ALLOWED AT DESIGNATED TIMES AND AREAS ONLY.
7. BE ON TIME FOR ALL SCHEDULED TRAINING.
8. CAMERAS, VIDEO, AND AUDIO EQUIPMENT PROHIBITED ON PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY ABC.
9. COMPLETION OF THE TRAINING COURSE DOES NOT GUARANTEE SUCCESSFUL PASSAGE OF THE SKILLS TEST OR QUALIFICATION FOR LICENSE.
10. PROPER CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR FOR WEATHER CONDITIONS AND PROPER OPERATION OF THE VEHICLE.
11. WE WILL NEED TO RETAIN A PHOTO COPY OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS IN THE STUDENT FILE:
 - Drivers License (front & back)
 - Temporary Instruction Permit. (TIP)
 - D.O.T. Physical Card

NOTICE: Completion of this course does not guarantee that student will pass the training program, Road Skills Test, be employed, or will be licensed by the Secretary of State. Applicant is under no obligation to take the Road Skills Test with ABC Training and Testing. ABC graduates choosing to test with us will receive one (1) complimentary road skills test with our truck.

This agreement takes precedence over any and all previous written agreements or oral understanding that either party may have signed or understood was to have been in place. It is understood that failure to abide by these conditions may result in termination of training and forfeiture of all fees paid. It is expressly agreed that the host organization, training organization and instructors shall not be held liable for any injury sustained by student before, during and after training. Student agrees to indemnify and hold harmless against all claims, damages, costs and expenses, including attorney's fees arising from or in connection with said training. With the knowledge and understanding of all of the above, the parties to this agreement do hereby sign said agreement.
